JULY 2016 MEETING BENCHING RESULTS

JUDGES CHOICE: *Corybas pruinosus*

This species is an autumn and winter flowering NSW species found along the coast and in the ranges up to about 700 metres. It is normally found in damp heavy shady rainforest or wet sclerophyll forests growing underneath damp loving plants such as ferns. It has also been reported from South Eastern Queensland. It grows cold and wet. This particular plant was grown beautifully by Trish Peterson inside a pot with an upturned glass bowl that fitted the pot just perfectly. Hence the humidity inside the pot can be maintained similar to that of its natural habitat.

OPEN BEST OF EVENING (50% Culture & 50% Flowers) *Pleurothallis palliolata*. This species is found in Costa Rica and Panama, growing at elevations of 1200-2100 metres. It is a cool growing species that prefers shaded conditions. I increased the light levels of a plant of mine last year and quite by accident came to the conclusion that if you want to propagate it, increase the light levels and keikis will grow where the flowers should be. A beautifully grown plant by Dora Law.

NOVICE/INTERMEDIATE BEST OF EVENING (50% Culture & 50% Flowers) *Oncidesa Juihbao Gold*. This hybrid is a cross between *Oncidesa Shonan* x *Oncidesa Kaizumic Delight* and was made by Ching Hua Orchids of Taiwan in the year 2000. In its background are *Gomesa marshalliana*, *Gonesa varicosa*, *Oncidium maculatum* and *Oncidium sphacelatum*. It is recommended to grow this hybrid in dappled light to bright indirect light with intermediate to warm conditions. Like many Oncidiinae they like to almost dry out between watering.

POPULAR CHOICE *Miltoniopsis (Mps. Jersey x Mps. Anne Port) x Mps. Leo Holguin* Grown by Rod Nurthen. Not the easiest to grow in Sydney. Rod's blooms are best described as Big Bold and Beautiful.
