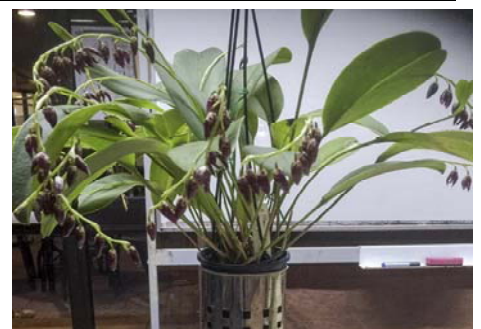

NEW NAMES

Ela Kielich: The new name for your *Den. mohlianum x glomeratum* is ***Den. (Dendrobium) Hsinying Glomo*** and was registered by Ching Hua Orchids of Taiwan in 2009. In addition, your *Den. glomeratum x chrysopterum* is ***Den. (Dendrobium) Hsinying Chrysopense*** and was also registered by Ching Hua Orchids of Taiwan in 2003 {N.B. Both *Den. sulawesiense* and *Den. crepidiferum* are synonyms for *Den. glomeratum*. [Ref: KEW Royal Botanic Gardens World Checklist of Selected Plant Families (WCSP)]}

George Serhan: The new name for your *Cym. Margaret Thatcher x Cym. Gwen Thomas* is ***Cym. (Cymbidium) Leshenault Dream*** and was registered by W Cruickshank of WA in 2014.

Clover Bradley: The new name for your *Sarco. Galaxy x hartmanii* is ***Sarco. (Sarcochilus) Space Race*** and was registered by David Butler in 2015.

Bryan Spurrs: The new name for your *Sarco. Kellie x Snowhart* is ***Sarco. (Sarcochilus) Fiona*** and was registered by David Butler in 2013.

Evelyn Tse: The new name for your *Den. Tie-Dye x speciosum* is ***Den. (Dendrobium) Mondrook*** and was registered by Ray Clements in 2003.

G & S W Cook: The current accepted name for your *Pleurothallis restrepioides* is ***Ste. (Stelis) restrepioides***.

Dora Law: Your plant named *Colmanara Masai* is unregistered and is probably meant to be *Colmanara Masai Red* which is a synonym for ***Ons. (Oncostele) Midnight Miracles***. (See explanation under Best of Evening below.)

AUGUST MEETING RESULTS

ORCHID OF THE MONTH Judges Choice *Cym. Serhan's Passion 'Marion'* G Serhan

This Cymbidium hybrid was first made by Bryant's Orchids of Kurnell in 2005 and registered in the same year by George Serhan. The parents are *Cym. Lancashire Khan* & *Cym. Blazing Fury*.

BEST OF EVENING (50% culture, 50% flower)

Open *Ons. Midnight Miracles* (Syn. *Colm. Masai Red 'Pink'*) Dora Law

The name *Colmanara Masai* is not entered in the Register of Orchid Hybrids and has caused much confusion in orchid circles over the past few years. The only registered *Colmanara Masai* is *Colmanara Masai Red*, which was registered by Anthura B. V. in Holland in 2007, but has now been given synonym status by the RHS due to being previously registered in 1983 by Hu-Bro & originated by Truford; both of the USA (Ref: RHS International Orchid Hybrid Register.) The current accepted name for this very popular hybrid is ***Oncostele (Ons.) Midnight Miracles***, the parents of which are *Rhynchostele bictoniensis x Oncidium cariniferum*. It has proven to be a very desirable orchid both for the orchid grower and as a houseplant, particularly in Europe, thanks to mass production. It is very variable in colour, particularly in the labellum. To add to the confusion, it is labelled under several common names such as 'Masai', 'Masai Pink' and 'Masai Splash'.

Nov/Inter *Stelis restrepioides* G & S W Cook

This popular Pleurothallid is found between 1400 and 3000 metres in Colombia, Ecuador and Peru. It requires intermediate conditions, but grows well in protected Sydney environs without heat.

POPULAR VOTE *Mps. Rouge x Mps. Red Knight* L & G Bromley

Both parents of this Miltoniopsis have spectacular, large blooms which catch the eye in any show. It comes as no surprise that a cross of these two orchids will have an excess of "WOW" factor. Miltoniopsis hybrids are not seen so much these days in Sydney. Perhaps they will make a welcome return to popularity.
